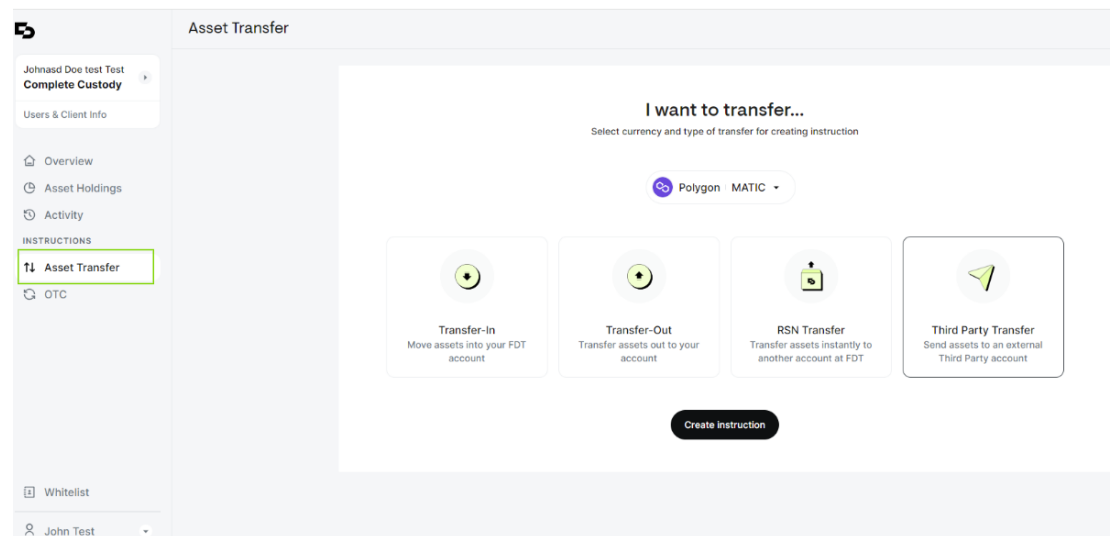


Create Third-Party Transfer (Crypto) Instructions

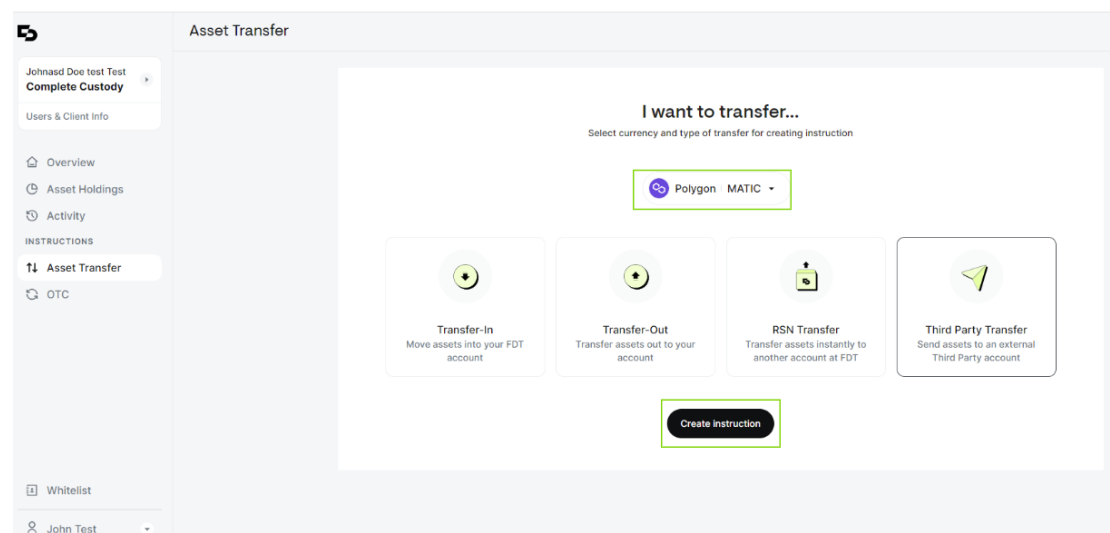

To transfer assets out to a third-party wallet address, you need to create a Third-Party Transfer instruction through the Client Portal.

1. Navigate to the **"Asset Transfer"** tab on the left panel.



2. From the dropdown menu at the top, select the cryptocurrency you would like to transfer. Choose **"Third-Party Transfer"** and click on the **"Create Instruction"** button.



3. Complete the required fields in this section:

- From my FDT Account: Choose the First Digital account you would like to transfer assets from

- To Wallet: Choose from your list of whitelisted crypto wallet addresses
- Amount: Enter the desired transfer amount.

Click on the "**Next**" button to proceed.
