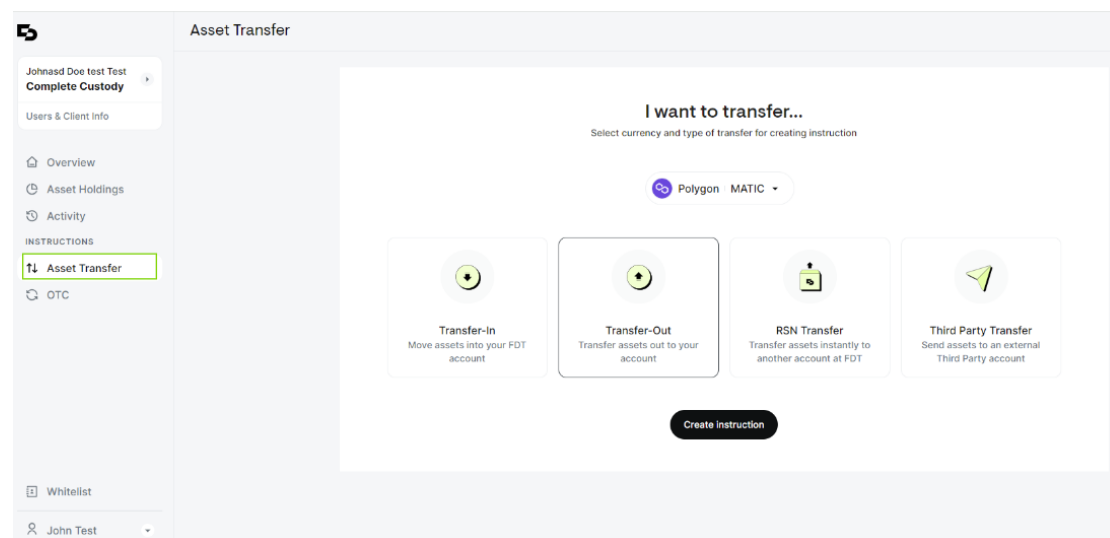


# Create Transfer-Out (Crypto) Instructions

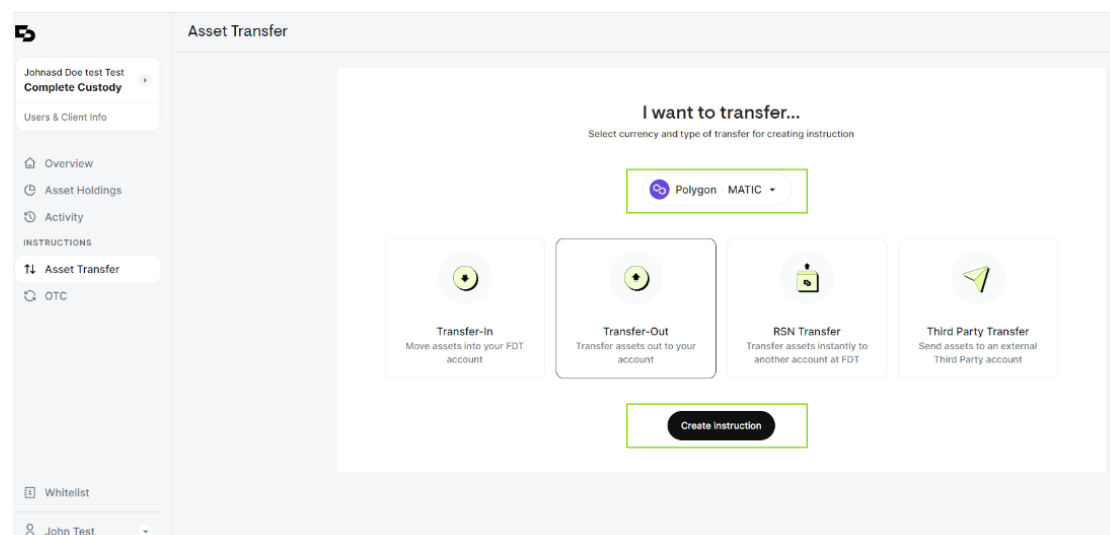

To initiate a payment/transfer of crypto assets, follow these steps in the Portal:

1. Navigate to the **"Asset Transfer"** tab on the left panel.



2. Select a digital currency from the dropdown menu at the top. Then, choose **"Transfer-Out"** and click on the **"Create Instruction"** button.



3. Complete the required fields:

- **From my FDT Account:** Choose the First Digital account you would like to transfer assets from
- **To Wallet:** Choose from your list of whitelisted crypto wallet addresses

- **Amount:** Enter the desired transfer amount.

Click on the "Next" to proceed.
